Your Journey day by day

Day 01: Arrive in Kathmandu

Our representative welcomes you at the Tribhuvan International Airport when you arrive in Kathmandu. After completing all the formalities, transfer to the hotel in a luxurious private vehicle. Spend the rest of the day taking a rest and relaxing. If you wish to take some sightseeing around nearby places.

Day 02: Kathmandu Sightseeing: Swayambhunath, Kathmandu, Patan Durbar Square (B)

The first day in Kathmandu begins with sightseeing around Swayambhunath Stupa. Have breakfast and then, we head towards the stupa. This stupa is popularly known as 'Monkey Temple'. Enjoy the breathtaking views of the Kathmandu Valley from the hilltop. In the surroundings of the Stupa, there are numerous Buddha statues, a big Vajra, small chaityas, a small museum, and monasteries. You can see many monkeys roaming around the premise. The huge spiral stupa with wisdom eyes symbol and beneath is a big white dome looks very impressive. The fragrance of butter lamps and incense creates the surrounding atmosphere more blissful.



Then, visit the Chinese Embassy to apply for the Tibet Visa with all the necessary documents. It is necessary to apply for at least three days before the Tibet visit and Kathmandu is the only International destination to go to Tibet besides China.

Have lunch and we head to Patan Durbar Square for sightseeing. One of the three durbars in the Kathmandu Valley is listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The ancient King's palace, ancient old temples, Krishna Mandir, Patan Museum, beautiful courtyards, and artistically beautiful decorations in the architecture are impressive attractions here. Take some photos and back to Kathmandu.

Next, we visit another World Heritage Site Kathmandu Durbar Square. The Durbar Square in the middle of the city offers ancient heritages of the medieval period. The ancient palaces, in the vicinity there is the living Goddess Kumari, Taleju Temple, Kal Bhairav Temple, Hanuman Dhoka Museum, and Gaddi Baithak are some major attractions. In the evening, enjoy walking and exploring the streets and trying out some foods in the food court.

Day 03: Kathmandu Sightseeing: Pashupatinath, Bouddhanath, Bhaktapur City (B)

We continue the Kathmandu sightseeing. After breakfast, we visit the holy Pashupatinath Temple. One of the most essential Hindu temples in Nepal is dedicated to Lord Shiva. This World Heritage Site temple is situated on the bank of the Bagmati river. In the surroundings of the temple, there is a huge statue of the Ox. Visit the small shrines and other temples, and see the Sadhus.

Not far from there is another World Heritage Site called Boudhanath. This stupa is one of the biggest stupas in Nepal. This holy stupa is of great significance to Tibetan Buddhists. Many people perform the kora ritual by circulating the big dome in a clockwise direction. In the surroundings, you can also visit other monasteries. You can hear Tibetan praying chants, and smell the fragrance of butter lamps and incense which makes the place very delightful. You can also do some souvenir shopping and explore the markets as well as enjoy Tibetan cuisine.

Have lunch and we proceed towards beautiful and ancient Bhaktapur city for sightseeing. This is also listed in the World Heritage site which is one of the best examples of architecture and well-preserved culture. The Durbar Square has several attractions such as the 55-window palace, Nyatpole Temple, Siddhi Laxmi Temple, the Golden Gate, the National Art Museum, and so on. Besides this, get an amazing view of skillful porters making pots, wood carvings, and many handicrafts goods. You can buy some goods if you wish to or like. Also, try the famous Juju Dhau which is King Curd is special curd or yogurt prepared by locals. For memories, click some pictures and back to Kathmandu. Overnight in a luxury hotel.

Day 04: Fly from Kathmandu to Pokhara

We fly from Kathmandu to Pokhara on the scheduled flight. It takes approx. 30 minutes to reach Pokhara. Upon reaching, transfer to the hotel and rest a while. Then, explore the nearby tourist places if you reach



here in the morning. Else, in the evening, we visit the happening places in Pokhara. We attend some live music or folk songs and dance performing restaurants. Enjoy the performance, food, and some quality time over there.

Day 05: Sightseeing in Pokhara city

We wake up early in the morning to enjoy the sunrise. A short drive to Sarangkot in a comfortable private vehicle. From the Sarangkot hill point, witness one of the most amazing views of the sunrise over the panoramic Annapurna ranges and Dhaulagiri. Spend some time there and then, descend and drive back to the hotel. Have breakfast and proceed to the city sightseeing. We visit some famous landmarks such as the International Mountain Museum, Seti Gorge, Gupteshower Cave, and Davis falls. Have lunch and visit the Tal Barahi Lake in the middle of the Phewa Lake. Boating is the only way to get there. Enjoy boating in the vicinity of Machhapuchhre and other mountain ranges on the beautiful Phewa Lake. Later, roam around the lakeside and markets for shopping. Explore the nightlife.

Note: We have an option of sightseeing around Peace Stupa for interested travelers.

Day 06: Drive to Chitwan from Pokhara

After breakfast, drive to Chitwan in a luxury vehicle from Pokhara. It takes 4-5 hours to reach Chitwan. On a long drive, enjoy the beautiful scenery. Upon reaching the resort, take a rest for a while. Later, explore the nearby places or spend quality time at the resort. Overnight in a resort.

Day 07: Full-day activities in the Chitwan National Park

The first national park of Nepal is the Chitwan National Park. The park is home to a diverse range of flora and fauna. One-horned Rhinoceros, Royal Bengal Tiger, and Gharial are the major attractions. Besides this, during the Jungle Safari witness the various species of flowers, birds, and animals.

Today's fun activities are listed below:

Elephant Safari: One of the best ways to explore the national park is through Elephant Safari. By riding on the back of a professionally trained elephant, explore the park and witness some animals like deer, woodpeckers, one-horned rhinos, various bird species, and natural flowers and trees. You can also choose to do Jeep Safari if you don't prefer Elephant Safari.

Jungle Walk: Those who love nature and want to explore the national park more freely can choose a Jungle walk. The experts are there with you to show you the safe way and explain in detail your queries. Enjoy nature and carry a jungle walk taking your time.



Elephant Shower Bath: Next, we enjoy the elephant shower bath upon us at the Rapti river. Through its trunk, an elephant pours water on us which is a fun activity.

Canoeing trip: Another fun activity in the national park is canoeing. This canoeing trip takes you along the Rapti river on a canoe where you witness harmless Gharials and other aquatic creatures. After canoeing, stay at the Rapti river bank and witness several birds and enjoy the sunset view.

Visit traditional Tharu Village: In the surrounding area of the national park is the traditional Tharu village. The village is home to the Tharu natives. Later, visit this village and learn something about their culture and lifestyle.

Tharu Stick Dance and Tharu Cultural Dance: In the Tharu village, experience the unique tribal Tharu stick dance which is performed by Tharu men. The dance illustrates how wild animals are fearful of the villagers. Also, enjoy the Tharu cultural dance which shows their culture and tradition which they perform by wearing cultural dresses. After full-day sightseeing, back to the hotel

Day 08: Fly from Chitwan to Kathmandu

After breakfast, take a flight from Chitwan to Kathmandu. It takes approx. 20 minutes to arrive at Kathmandu Airport. After that, the guide transfers you to the hotel in a luxury vehicle. Take some rest and have lunch. The rest day is free. Visit the famous Thamel market and nearby places for souvenir shopping or just exploring. Day 09: Fly from Kathmandu to Lhasa

After breakfast or as per the flight schedule, we fly to Lhasa from Kathmandu. During the flight, enjoy the awesome views of the Himalayan mountain ranges. After 2 hours, arrive at Lhasa Gonggar Airport. The Tibetan guide welcomes you at the airport and then, transfers you to the hotel. Since Lhasa is at a high altitude from the sea level, it is very essential to acclimatize properly to prevent altitude sickness and adjust to the surroundings. Hence, spend a day taking a rest in the hotel.

Overnight at a Luxury Hotel – <u>St. Regis</u>, Lhasa

Day 10: Lhasa Sightseeing: Potala Place, Jokhang Temple, and Barkhor Street (B)

The first day in Lhasa commences with sightseeing. Early we visit the famous Potala Palace which is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The former winter palace of Dalai Lama lies at an elevation of 3750m from the sea level. At present, the palace is a museum that has several Buddhist murals, thangkas, mandalas, decorated stupa tombs, and audience halls. The palace is a 13-storey building that contains over 1,000 rooms, 10,000 shrines, and approx. 200,000 statues.



Next, we explore the holy Jokhang temple in the compound of the Potala Palace. This UNESCO-listed World Heritage Site has the gold statue of Jowo Rinpoche. Tibetan Buddhists considered this place as the spiritual center. Nearby this temple is the famous Barkhor Street. The street is famous for the kora ritual (circulating act) around the sacred Jokhang Temple. Besides this, it is a favorite shopping street for Tibetan goods and original crafts.

Overnight at a Luxury Hotel – St. Regis, Lhasa

Day 11: Lhasa Sightseeing: Drepung Monastery and Sera Monastery (B)

You visit the two essential monasteries during today's Lhasa sightseeing. First, you visit the Drepung Monastery which was founded in 1416. One of the Great three largest monasteries of the Gelug School of Tibetan Buddhism. It used to be the seat of the central government before the Potala Palace. The academic study standard here is considered high so that's why it is popularly known as the 'Nalanda of Tibet'

After lunch, explore the Sera Monastery which is also one of the Great three largest monasteries in Tibet. It was founded in 1419 and has Great Assembly Hall and three popular colleges i.e. the Sera Je Dratsang, the Sera Me Dratsang, and the Ngakpa Dratsang. The colorful rock painting of Buddha, three sand mandalas, and the Tibetan religious text printing house are the prime attractions. The major highlight here is the interesting monk debate in the courtyard at around 3-5 pm.

Day 12: Fly from Lhasa to your next destination

FAQS

What permits and travel documents do I need for a tour of Tibet and Nepal?

While issuing the permits, make sure that you have all the necessary valid documents. For Tibet Tours, provide all documents to your travel agency to apply for a Tibet permit which is issued by Tibet Tourism Bureau to enter Tibet. It takes about 12 days to complete the procedure.

To travel to Tibet and Nepal, you need the following permits and travel documents:

- **1. Passport:** A valid passport (with at least 6 months date remaining)
- **2. Chinese Visa**: You need a Chinese Visa if you are traveling to Tibet from China. Obtain a visa from a Chinese embassy or consulate in your home country.

Tibet Travel Permit (from China): You require Tibet Travel Permit to enter Tibet. It is issued by Tibet Tourism Bureau. You must stay 1 night in China outside Tibet. Then, your travel agency will send the hard copy of the permit where you are staying.

3. Nepal Visa: You can easily get an on-arrival Nepal visa.

Tibet Travel Permit (from Nepal): Besides China, Nepal is the only country where you can directly fly to Tibet. You must apply for a Tibet Group Visa. To complete the process, at least it takes 3 days. And, your original passport will be at the Chinese Embassy in Kathmandu during this process.

4. Alien's Travel Permit:

This permit is issued by the Public Security Bureau of Tibet. This permit is essential to foreigners traveling outside Lhasa like Shigatse, Rongbuk Monastery, Northern Everest Base Camp. If you are traveling outside Lhasa, then it is issued by your travel agency once you arrived in Tibet. It cannot be issued from Kathmandu or other cities in China.

How to obtain travel permits for a Tibet-Nepal tour?

Travel permits for Tibet-Nepal require the following things and the procedure may vary depending on the nations in which you issue the permit.

Tibet Tourism Bureau Permit Procedure:

• Tibet Tourism Bureau Permit (TTB) usually takes about 12 working days to apply. Travelers must provide the required documents & information before applying for TTB. You can send it from



your home country to your travel agency.

For the Travel Permit from Kathmandu, Nepal:

- It takes at least 3 working days to get the Tibet group visa for the Tibet tour which requires your original passport and photographs. Your passport will be in the Chinese embassy in Kathmandu within these days. (Working days: Monday to Friday)
- If you already have a Chinese visa but you want to travel to Tibet via Kathmandu, your Chinese visa will be canceled from the Chinese embassy in Kathmandu and provide you Tibet group visa only.

For the Travel Permit from China or your home country:

• If you already have a Chinese visa or want to apply from your country, you have to travel via China mainland for a Tibet tour. Your travel agency will send the hard copy of the Travel permit to your hotel where you will spend 1 night in China mainland (Eg: Chengdu, Beijing, Shanghai, etc.). Without a travel permit, you won't be able to visit Tibet.

It is important to obtain all the necessary permits and visas, including the Tibet Travel Permit, and the Tibet Group Visa. We also recommend you seek the advice of a reputable travel agency that specializes in travel to Tibet and Nepal to ensure a safe and enjoyable journey.

What is the best time of year to travel to Tibet and Nepal?

The best time for traveling to Nepal and Tibet are:

Nepal: Nepal is best to travel all around the year. Each season has something to offer.

- **Spring (Mar-May) and Autumn (Sep-Nov):** Moderate weather, Clear skies, and stable temperature. During the day is warm and colder in the mountains than in the lower regions.
- Winter (Dec-Feb): Clear views, cool weather, but slightly warm during the day. But, expect snowfalls in the higher regions.

Tibet: Tibet is situated on a high plateau and at a high elevation than Nepal. So, experiences low temperatures and frost for most of the months.

- Summer season (Jun-Aug): Best season to travel to Tibet. The oxygen level in the atmosphere is high during this season which helps travelers to properly acclimatize.
- Tibet remains closed in February and March for foreigners to travel. Sometimes until early April, Tibet can remain closed.
- Therefore, we suggest you check the weather forecast and road conditions before traveling. Plan your trip with the assistance of a trustworthy travel agency that specializes in Tibet and Nepal travel.



What are the different modes of transportation to travel between Tibet and Nepal?

Then you will leave for Kathmandu via Gyirong Port by road or take a flight from Lhasa.

There are various modes of transportation to travel between Tibet and Nepal. They are:

Flight: The quickest and the best option is flight. Whether you are in China or Nepal, you can take a direct flight to Tibet.

Train (only from China): It is the cheapest means to travel to Tibet from China. If time permits, you can take a direct train to Lhasa via the Qinghai-Tibet Railway.

Overland Journey: It is the cheapest means of transportation. Drive through the Himalayan mountain ranges trail of Nepal to Tibet. Reach the Gyirung port via Rasuwa Gadhi from Kathmandu. From Gyirung port, travel to Lhasa and enjoy the beautiful scenery in a private or public vehicle.

What is the most recommended way to travel from Tibet to Nepal?

You can travel to Nepal from Tibet both by air and by land. It depends on your preference. But, we recommend you travel via land. Go on an overland journey to Nepal through the highways of Lhasa. Get an opportunity to experience beautiful scenery, landscapes, the Tibetan plateau, the Himalayan mountain range, and the lush valleys of Nepal.

As your preference, you can join a tour group or do a private tour. It includes transportation, accommodation, and a guide. Hence, it is stress-free and you can completely enjoy the tour.

What are the options for crossing the border between Tibet and Nepal?

The only open border Gyirung (Kyirong or Kerung) is the option for traveling between Tibet and Nepal. It is only 24 km from Gyirung to Rasuwa Gadhi (Nepal).

Tibet to Nepal by road: At the border, you just need to provide a valid passport, one photo, the completed application form, and the visa fee in dollars. Then, you can enter Nepal.

Nepal to Tibet by road: You travel via the Gyirung border. You need to get a Chinese Visa and Tibet travel permit in advance. On-arrival Visa is not available at the Gyirung border.

It is best to arrange all documents and permits in advance for Tibet and Nepal overland journey.

What is the approximate cost of a trip to Tibet and Nepal?

The cost of the trip completely depends on you. If you go for a luxurious trip or private tour, then the cost



of the trip will be higher. If you go for a budget trip or join a group tour, the trip cost will be slightly lesser.

Tibet trip cost: Tibet tour is only possible through an organized group tour. Solo Tibet travel is not allowed. Since all arrangements are managed by the travel agency and include all accommodation and facilities, the trip cost is slightly higher. Even if you are on budget travel, it is expensive compared to Nepal.

Nepal trip cost: It is economical as compared to Tibet. You can control your expenses and manage them on your own. You can plan the trip as your budget and choose the accommodation and facilities according to it.

As far as the approximate cost is concerned, the per-day cost can range from 100 USD to 500 USD. So, plan wisely and budget accordingly.

What is the current situation for tourism in Tibet? Can tourists visit Tibet now?

Ltd</u> is delighted to inform you of the re-opening to <u>Tibet Tours</u> **from April 2023 onwards**. *Tibet is open to all international tourists now*. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Tibet tour for international tourists and the borders between Nepal and Tibet, (China) were closed.

On April 7, 2023, the Ministry of Culture and Tourism of China issued notice to resume national travel agencies and online travel companies to operate foreign inbound group tours and "air ticket & hotel" business, enabling the re-opening of Tibet tourism to all international tourists.

To travel to Tibet, tourists must obtain a <u>Tibet travel permit</u>, which can be acquired through an official Tibet travel agency. Asia Experiences is one such travel agency that can take care of the permit application on behalf of tourists.

.....

As of now, Tourism in Tibet has been still impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. Thus, there are restrictions imposed by the Chinese government to prevent the spread of the virus. As of February 2023, the situation in Tibet remains uncertain, and the availability of tourist visas and permits is subject to change.

Currently, China has reopened its borders to foreign travelers with some restrictions. But, the situation is still fluid. Also, it is important to keep up to date with the latest regulations and requirements. Hope it will open Tibet to international tourists very soon. Additionally, there may be other restrictions or requirements in place for entry into China, such as quarantine requirements or specific health and vaccination certificates.
