Trip Overview

Kathmandu Chitwan wildlife Tour is suitable for all kind of travelers. Those who want to explore cultural and historical cities, temples, monasteries and jungle safari for vacation in the sunshine.

Kathmandu is one of the most famous cultural and historical cities of Nepal. In Kathmandu valley normally exploring the all [UNESCO world's heritage sites](#) including many different places mainly Pashupatinath (Hindu Temple), Boudhanath stupa (Buddhist), Swoyambhunath (Monkey Temple), Kathmandu Durbar and Patan Durbar Square.

Chitwan National Park is one of Nepal's most popular tourist destinations. The National park lies in the lowland of the Terai Region also called a World Heritage Site. The visitor who wants to see the [natural wildlife](#) and do like jeep safaris, bird watching, canoe and elephant ride as well as jungle activities and learn about Tharu culture and many more. Amidst diverse flora and fauna, Chitwan National Park's highlights are the rare Royal Bengal Tiger and the one-horned rhino. Also, the enlightening experience is the tradition and culture of the people in the village, namely Tharu and the tribals. They are among the native people of Nepal.

Your Journey day by day

Day 01 Arrive in Kathmandu (B)

Arrive at the international airport in Kathmandu. You will be welcomed by a garland of seasonal flowers. Then transfer to hotel by our cultural guides on AC vehicle. The guide will explain the program of your Tour in detail. Normally because of jet leg, this day is free to do rest. If you are ready to start sightseeing we can start on the same day, we are always flexible.

Day 02 Sightseeing to world heritage sites of Kathmandu valley (B)

We start our day by visiting Pashupatinath, a sacred Hindu Shrine for Hindus all over the world. It is located at the bank of Bagmati River and here you can see many small temples as well that are rich in art and a view of craftsmanship can be seen in Pashupatinath. Bagmati River is also the cremation site for Hindus.

Next, we move towards Boudhanath Stupa one of the biggest stupas. The surrounding around the Stupa is quite attractive and has a local market around. It is also enlisted under UNESCO world heritage site.

Kathmandu Durbar square in front of the old royal palace of the former Kathmandu Kingdom is one of the UNESCO world heritage sites. Durbar square is surrounded by outstanding architecture and richly displays the skills of the Newar artists and craftsmen from many centuries.

Swayambhunath Stupa is one of the famous Buddhist temple located on top of the hill. You can view the beautiful Kathmandu valley from the temple. It is considered the most prominent site to relax and gaze at Kathmandu city.

Day 03 Fly or drive to Chitwan (B/L/D)

After breakfast, drive to Chitwan approximately 5-6 hours by road or by flight (optional) in 25 minutes. In Chitwan tour will be followed by visiting local villages. Meet Tharus, the native of the southern plain of Nepal. In the evening an entertainment program of Tharu stick dance.

Day 04 Chitwan National Park jungle Safari tour (B/L/D)

Elephant back safari into the wild, nature walk and a visit to elephant breeding camp. Canoeing along Rapti River, if lucky enough view of Royal Bengal Tiger in the dense forest on Elephant Safari. The National Park is best known for Royal Bengal Tigers, One - Horned Rhinos, python, monkeys, wild boar, marsh crocodile leopards and many more.

Day 05 Fly or drive to Kathmandu (B)

Early morning explore the bird watching tour at Chitwan national park. After breakfast, We will drive towards Kathmandu. After 5 hours' drive we reach Kathmandu, today we can relax and move around the city.

Kathmandu is also known for shopping and beautiful markets.

Day 06 Sightseen and optional mountain flight or Everest Base-camp Heli tour (B)

Early morning, optional mountain flight through modern jet-stream aircraft and feel the splendid Himalayas from approximately 25,000 feet.

Our optional fascinating Helicopter tour to Everest base camp from Kathmandu, landing at mt. Everest base camp Kala Patthar with the best view of Sagarmatha (Mt. Everest). This trip is on a chopper to world's highest valley of Khumbu and Mount Everest region. Early morning depart from respective hotels and get transferred to Kathmandu domestic airport. This flight is mind-blowing and wonderful helicopter flight towards mt. Everest base camp. Soon after taking off from the airport we see the panorama of green hills and Kathmandu valley. we get the awesome parallel range of snow-capped mountains towards west Mt. Manaslu, Ganesh Himal, Langtang and Jugal Himal. As the flight continues more views of mid-east and far eastern Himalayan peaks of Mt. Gaurishankar, Melung Tse, Number, Cho-Oyu. Through the cockpit can point Mt. Everest, Lhotse and as far as Mt. Makalu.

Afternoon, tour to Bhaktapur Durbar Square, the open museum with a beautiful palace, sculptures, Shikhara style temples, royal bath, and a Buddhist monastery.

Day 07 Final Departure (B)
