Day 02 Tour of Bhaktapur Durbar Square, Pashupatinath Temple, Boudhanath Stupa

About half an hour's drive from your hotel will see you at the heart of Bhaktapur. **Bhaktapur** is the smallest district of Nepal abundant with cultural and religious heritages. The Durbar square is aesthetically beautiful



and a true example of arts and crafts. There are 33 temples in the vicinity of Durbar Square. This ancient city is every traveler's delight.

Following the Bhaktapur tour, we will visit a couple of more sites in Kathmandu. The first place will be the Hindu Temple of **Pashupatinath** beside the holy Bagmati River. Get to know more about the Hindu traditions and rites in your time here. Next, we will take a brief drive to the **Boudhanath** Stupa. Explore the Tibetan inspired streets and try some popular snacks in Boudhanath. You will return to the hotel after a majestic sunset view from Boudhanath stupa.

Renowned for its stunning views of the iconic Machhapuchhre (Fish Tail) mountain, the lodge offers a perfect blend of natural beauty and modern comfort.

A fun day trip begins with sightseeing around Pokhara. Pokhara is a famous tourist hub. A day commences with a short hike to Sarangkot. A beautiful viewpoint for sunrise and sunset over Annapurna and Dhaulagiri ranges, and Machhapuchhre. Sarangkot is famous for paragliding



as well. One can perform paragliding as an adventurous sport. Witness a great view of Pokhara Valley from the top. Descend back to Pokhara. Tal Barahi temple, Davis Falls, Gupteshor Cave, Bats Cave, Peace Stupa, and the International Mountain Museum are the major highlights of Pokhara City. Experience all the place tours and make some great memories.

Day 05 Return Flight to Kathmandu and Tour of Swoyambhu Stupa and Patan city

Time: 30 minutes flight **Meals:** Breakfast **Accomodation:** Dwarika's Hotel



You will return to Kathmandu by a flight in the afternoon from Pokhara.



After check in Kathmandu hotel, we head towards the Swoyambhu stupa. This stupa is popularly known as 'Monkey Temple'. Enjoy the breathtaking views of the Kathmandu Valley from the hilltop. In the surroundings of the Stupa, there are numerous Buddha statues, a big Vajra, small chaityas, a small museum, and monasteries. You can see many monkeys roaming around the premise. The huge spiral stupa with wisdom eyes symbol and beneath is a big white dome looks very impressive. The fragrance of butter lamps and incense creates the surrounding atmosphere more blissful.

About half an hour's drive from your hotel will see you at the heart of Patan or Lalitpur city. One of the three major cities of the Kathmandu valley, Patan is known for the arts and architecture in its streets, monuments, and temples. The Patan Durbar Square is your first destination here. Some of the highlights of the Durbar (Palace) region are the beautiful Krishna Mandir, Bhimsen and Vishwanath Temples, and beautiful courtyards. Also, visit the Tibetan Refugee camp and painting shops while you are in Patan.

Day 06 Flight to Bhutan, Drive to Thimphu and Thimphu Tour

Time: 1.15 hours flight Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner Accomodation: Pemako (Previously Taj Tashi)







We have a morning flight to Bhutan today. After leaving Kathmandu, a brief flight will take us to Paro

Airport. Your Bhutanese guide will meet you at the airport and you will take a short drive (1 hour) to Thimphu. Along the ride, the guide will brief you through the Bhutan part of the tour. Stop halfway to the Paro-Thimphu highway and visit the

16th-century old Tachogang Lhakhang temple by traversing an old bridge. From the bridge, enjoy the scenic views of the villages. Tachogang temple means the hill of the excellent horse.

Continue to drive to

Thimphu. After arriving at the Bhutanese capital, rest for a while and start your Thimphu Tour.


You can explore some of the major attractions around Thimphu today which include the Giant Buddha Dordenma Statue, Third King Memorial Stupa, National Library of Bhutan, Bhutan Postal Museum, Folk Heritage Museum, Thimphu Dzong, and more. In the evening explore the local market and get closer to local culture and commerce.

Day 07 Thimphu to Punakha excursion- back to Thimphu

Time: 2 hours oneway drive **Meals:** Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner **Accomodation:** Pemako (Previously Taj Tashi)







Head towards Punakha after breakfast today. The drive is about two hours long and passes through the Beautiful Dochula Pass. We will stop at the pass and spend some time at the royal botanical garden and Druk Wangyal Chortens. The pristine view of the Himalayas in clear weather is one to behold. We will continue the journey to Punakha following the stop.

The Chimi Lakhang temple on the way will be our first stop. This unique temple is also known as 'the temple of the divine madman'. The Punakha Dzong is next on our list. One of the most beautiful and historically significant fortresses in Bhutan, Punakha Dzong is one not to miss here. A few miles from there is the oldest and the longest Punakha Suspension Bridge. It connects three villages in Bhutan and the views from the bridge are impressive. We will return to Thimphu after the Punakha Tour in the evening.

Day 08 Drive to Paro and Tigers Nest Hiking & Paro valley tour

Time: 4-6 hrs hiking Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner Accomodation: Uma Paro







After breakfast, drive to Paro. The Hike to Taktsang Monastery is a proven delight for travelers to experience nature and spirituality as a whole in Bhutan. The hike might be challenging for some but it truly is worth a couple of hours' hike from Paro. You can have a slow and gradual walk with breaks in the midway shops.

Once there witness the majestic view of the pristine Taktsang monastery carved into a giant cliff. Know the legends of the great Guru Padmasambhava and explore the beautiful monastery. Also, visit the caves inside the monastery and interact with the monks there. Return from the hike, have lunch and visit some more local monasteries, the beautiful Drukgyel Dzong, Paro Dzong, the National Museum of Bhutan, and Kyichu Lhakhang Temple to end your Paro tour.

You will stay at the Uma Paro hotel today. Como Uma Paro is an intimate and exclusive luxury hotel in the heart of Paro Valley popular for its fantastic Himalayan views.


We suggest to do walking tour of Ason local marke and World Heritage Site Kathmandu Durbar Square. The Durbar Square in the middle of the city offers ancient heritages of the medieval period. The ancient palaces, in the vicinity there is the living Goddess Kumari, Taleju Temple, Kal Bhairav Temple, Hanuman Dhoka Museum, and Gaddi Baithak are some major attractions. In the evening, enjoy walking and exploring the streets and trying out some foods in the food court.

We will drive you to the airport after breakfast for a flight to Lhasa from Kathmandu. You can enjoy a fantastic view of the Himalayas from the window during the flight. After landing in Lhasa your Tibetan

guide will receive you at the airport and transfer you to the hotel.



Lhasa is situated at an average elevation of 14000 feet above sea level. The fantastic view of landscapes follows you straight from the airport throughout the Tibetan tour. Day 11 Visit Potala Palace, Jokhang temple, Barkhor bazaar

Time: 4-5 hrs Meals: Breakfast Accomodation: St. Regis





You will kick off the Lhasa tour with a visit to the beautiful Potala Palace. Located within a short drive this palace was the home of Dalai Lamas, the spiritual leader of Tibetan people. Exploring the UNESCO world heritage site witness the wonderful sculptures, Chapels, Thangkas, Murals, and many more. Explore the allowed sections of this massive palace and spend some time in the ponds and park behind it.



Towards late afternoon we will head towards Jokhang Temple. Jokhang Temple is the spiritual center of Tibet holding many beliefs and significance. The temple architecture is beautiful and is inspired by Vihara and Nepalese style. The Barkhor square in front holds different memories of historic events and celebrations as well. Explore artifacts and paintings of different periods here in the temple.

Day 12 Drepung Monastery, Sera Monastery, and Norbulingka Palace

Time: 4-5 hrs Meals: Breakfast Accomodation: St. Regis





Our Lhasa tour continues and we will visit the remaining major destinations here today. Starting the day we will take a short drive to Drepung Monastery after breakfast. This expansive monastery houses some of the oldest Buddhist writings, Murals, and Thangkas. Visit the courtyards and chapels alongside the Nechung Oracle temple nearby. We will visit the Mentshekhang (Chinese traditional hospital) next today. Learn more about some of the Tibetan ancient diagnostics and medicine while you are here.

Sera Monastery is next on our list which is among the biggest Gelug university monasteries in Lhasa. Within a short drive from Potala, you can get closer to the lifestyle and culture of local monks here. Explore the chapel, courtyard, and other beautiful components of the monastery in your visit.

In the afternoon we will head towards another UNESCO world heritage site, the Norbulings Palace. Norbulingka was the summer residence of the Dalai Lamas. You can visit the major buildings, chapels, and monuments in this palace. The garden surrounding Norbulinga palace is another attraction of the beautiful palace. Spend some time there before returning to your hotel.
